I, the undersigned, hereby declare that:

- It is my desire to serve in the Israeli Defense Forces, and hereby request to volunteer for said service for a period of _____ months from the day of my induction into the Machal track.
- I am aware that after this request is approved, I will not be able to cancel my volunteer duty, except with the authorization or the appropriate authority.
- I am aware, and agree to the fact, that in light of my volunteering to serve I will be obligated by all the laws and regulations which affect soldiers serving in the army in accordance with their legal duty. In addition, the conditions of my service, including pay and calculation of length of service, will be identical to those used with all soldiers serving in the army.
- I understand that this declaration in no way obligates the army to draft me if the army comes to the conclusion that because of the army's needs or my personal criterion, it is not appropriate to draft me.
- To the best of my knowledge I am not, nor have I ever been, a citizen of Israel.
- To the best of my knowledge I am medically fit to serve and as proof attach medical referral testifying to my fitness to serve.
- My last entry date to Israel was ______, and I live here without my parents.
- I am obligated to immediately notify the Army of any change in my civilian standing, the effect of which might be a change in the period of service in the IDF, in accordance with the Law of Obligatory Service.
- If I choose, for any reason, to extend my service in the Army, I promise to extend my permit from Machal with the Ministry of the Interior.
- I understand that my final draft date will be declared right after I'll finish all the tests at Lishkat HaGiyus.
